Meet the Adjust-A-Bench, from the season premiere of Ask This Old House

Following the premiere of the 2010 season of **Ask This Old House**, many readers wrote in asking about Tom Silva's new adjustable-height workbench. So, here's what you need to know about the workshop's cool new addition, including how to pick one up for yourself.

Meet the **Adjust-A-Bench** by Noden, which can be adjusted to 12 different levels with a total range of 16.5 inches. Steel rails of the bench are designed to retrofit with your current workbench top. For committed DIYers, a workbench like this one is a solid investment in the ultimate workspace. You can get a 60 x 30 bench for about \$800, or a 72 x 30 bench for about \$850. Assembly is required.
