

## **Noden Adjust-A-Bench**

The Noden Adjust-A-Bench was nominated for providing a solid, stable work surface that changes height quickly and with ease. It provides a comfortable, effective range of access to your work surface, increasing the overall efficiency of your existing workbench.

"When I first saw this bench at a trade show, I thought it was a bit pricey and that I could build one myself for a lot less," said reader Glenn Warner of Ringoes, N.J., who admits he was wrong.

The bench features a pair of nesting frames designed to retrofit with rails to a worker's existing bench top. Made from 1/8"-thick mild steel with a powder-coated finish, the frames stand 26-1/4" high and add a range of adjustment of 16-1/2" to a bench's height through their unique ratchet mechanism. The inner tray slides vertically through 12 stops, which lock with a ratchet. A convenient foot pedal releases the locking stops.

"The whole thing rides on outriggered casters [supplied by Noden], and that combined with the easily adjustable height is what makes this a much-used multifunction tool — assembly bench, infeed table, portable spray platform, mobile loading and unloading dock, and in-shop scaffold. And as an added bonus it can be used by my 7-year-old grandson whose height is also adjusting rapidly," said Warner.

The Noden Adjust-A-Bench sells for \$705. With a set of castors, the price comes to \$865.
