


## Workbench for Short People, Tall People — Matter of Fact, All People

Is the height of your workbench always right? Have you, at times, wanted it higher? Or lower?

The Noden Adjust-A-Bench may be perfect for you. These heavy-duty leg assemblies allow you to raise and lower your bench's top 15 inches, from a height of about 28 inches — good for assembly work — to one of 43 inches — excellent for hand routing operations. A ratchet adjustment mechanism with a pedal-actuated release provides a stop every 1/8". Optional casters provide

a means of fine adjustment between ratchet stops and allow you to move the bench to use as a work support at various machines (table saw, band saw, drill press). The legs are strong enough to withstand all the pounding, pushing, and pulling your woodworking can deliver.

The \$380 Adjust-A-Bench consists of a pair of powder-coated metal leg assemblies that, together, weigh 78 pounds.
